

Human and yet so different

Our society is built on the multipolar involvement of men and women who, as best they can, demonstrate their intellectual and physical production capacities.

The question is: are they doing it to the best of their ability?

If yes, why?

If not, why not?

The answer to why has always been within our grasp, and for reasons of belief and non-belief, denial of difference and lack of knowledge and understanding of human behavior, we've wilfully "denied" this HUGE DIFFERENCE that exists between right-handed and left-handed people, right-handers and left-handers.

This difference has ramifications in all aspects of our lives, whether in the field of health and illness (physical and mental), in the dynamics of heterosexual and homosexual couples, in the work environment, in physical activities, in positive or negative reactions to medication, drugs or food, in the world of hierarchies and power plays and so on.

In my desire to offer better quality of care to improve my patients' quality of life, I discovered and understood the neuro-sociological key that enables us to manifest our full potential and thus MANIFEST THE BEST of ourselves.

The psychiatrist C.G.Jung was an important trigger in my observations and discoveries. Dr. Jung established that

every "woman" has a masculine (yang) nature called ANIMUS which plays a regulating role in her unconscious, and that every "man" has a feminine (yin) nature called ANIMA which plays a regulating role in his unconscious. The Jungian approach to the study and in-depth understanding of human nature opened up a gigantic window onto the unconscious and the exploration of the supra-conscious.

C.G.Jung had not taken into account all the nuances of right-handed and left-handed reality. With all due respect and gratitude to Professor Jung, I took the liberty of setting up a REVOLUTIONARY CONCEPT to CLARIFY the differences in the reality of the Animus in right-handed versus left-handed women, and the differences in the reality of the Anima in right-handed versus left-handed people.

I've named this REVOLUTIONARY CONCEPT: "Double Animus" in left-handed women versus "Animus" in right-handed women, and "Double Anima" in left-handed people versus "Anima" in right-handed people.

Then there's the discovery and understanding of the four different distinctive neuro-sociological patterns we identify in right-handers, left-handers, righties and lefties, which has enabled us to mathematically model different Seduction and Action Power Factors (S.A.P.F.) according to their dominant neuro-sociological Profiles (Feminine, very Feminine, hyper Feminine" or "Masculine, very Masculine, hyper Masculine). This F.P.S.A. highlights the enormous difference in the "social and sexual gaze" each of them has on the other.

Then there's the discovery of the "cornerstone" of the immense reality of Neuro-sociological Profiles: THE NOTION OF NEURO-SPATIAL. Where is OUR RIGHT PLACE in space and in our relationships with others? This aspect deserves our full attention, as it offers us the potential to MANIFEST THE BEST of who we are.

Our society is at a "major turning point" and needs to look at and approach solutions from a new angle of perception. These discoveries and understanding of the different models of Neuro-sociological Profiles of women and men offer a solution and an opportunity that must be seized by the various decision-making bodies, and thus offer an "additional option" for calming and smoothing out the many disturbances that our society is experiencing head-on.
